MATERIALS

(6 oz/170.1 g; 315 yards/288 m)

Main Color (MC) White 1

5 yards/4.5 m each of Black, Bone, and Gray Melange.

Wire brush.

US H/8 (5 mm) hook or size needed to obtain stitch size.

Stitch markers.

CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

SIZES

To fit **0/3 mos** (**3/6 mos**-**6/12 mos**-**2/4 years**-**6/10 years**-**Adult**).

GAUGE

13 sc and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Ch 2 at beg of rnd **does not** count as hdc.

With MC, ch 4. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring.

1st rnd: Ch 2. 9 hdc in ring. Join with sl st to top of ch 2.

2nd rnd: Ch 2. 2 hdc in each hdc around. Join with sl st to top of ch 2. 18 hdc.

3rd rnd: Ch 2. *1 hdc in next hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to top of ch 2. 27 hdc.

4th rnd: Ch 2. *1 hdc in each of next 2 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to top of ch 2. 36 hdc.

5th rnd: Ch 2. *1 hdc in each of next 3 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to top of ch 2. 45 hdc.

Size 3/6 mos only: 6th rnd: Ch 2. *1 hdc in each of next 8 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to top of ch 2. 50 hdc.



Sizes 6/12 mos, 2/4 yrs, 6/10 yrs and Adult only: 6th rnd: Ch 2. *1 hdc in each of next 4 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to top of ch 2. 54 hdc.

Sizes 2/4 yrs, 6/10 yrs and Adult only: 7th rnd: Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join with sl st to top of ch 2.

8th rnd: Ch 2. *1 hdc in each of next 8 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to top of ch 2. 60 hdc.

Sizes 6/10 yrs and Adult only: 9th rnd: Ch 2. *1 hdc in each of next (29-9) hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to top of ch 2. (62-66) hdc.

All sizes: Next rnd: Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join with sl st to top of ch 2.
Rep last rnd 8 (8-9-9-10-11) times more. **Do not** fasten off.

First Earflap

****1st row:** Ch 1. 1 dc in each of next 10 (10-10-10-12-12) hdc. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

2nd row: (WS). Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 6 (6-6-6-8-8) sc.

Sc2tog. Turn. 8 (8-8-8-10-10) sts.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

4th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Sc2tog. Turn. 6 (6-6-6-8-8) sts.

5th row: As 3rd row.

Rep last 2 rows to 4 sts.

Next row: (Sc2tog) twice. 2 sts.

Next row: Sc2tog. Fasten off.**

Fold Hat in half, with slightly more sts towards front of Hat than in the back. Place markers for 10 (10-10-10-12-12) hdc of Second Earflap to line up with First Earflap on opposite side.

Second Earflap

With RS facing, join MC with sl st at marker.

Work from ** to ** as given for First Earflap.

Eyes (make 2)

With Black, ch 2.

1st rnd: 10 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join Bone with sl st to first sc.

2nd rnd: With Bone, ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join MC with sl st to first sc. 20 sc.

3rd rnd: With MC, 1 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc.

4th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join Grey Heather with sl st to first sc. 30 sc.

5th rnd: With Grey Heather, ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

Nose

With Black, ch 5.

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 hdc in next ch. 1 dc in each of last 2 ch. Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Sew Eyes and Nose to front of Hat as shown in picture.

Loop strands of MC and tie between eyes. Comb with wire brush to 'fluff' and trim.

Braided Tails (make 2)

Cut 12 strands of MC 36" [91 cm] long. Take 6 strands tog and thread through end of Earflap. Knot at top.

Divide 12 strands into 3 groups of 4 strands and braid. Knot to secure braid. Use wire brush to fluff ends!

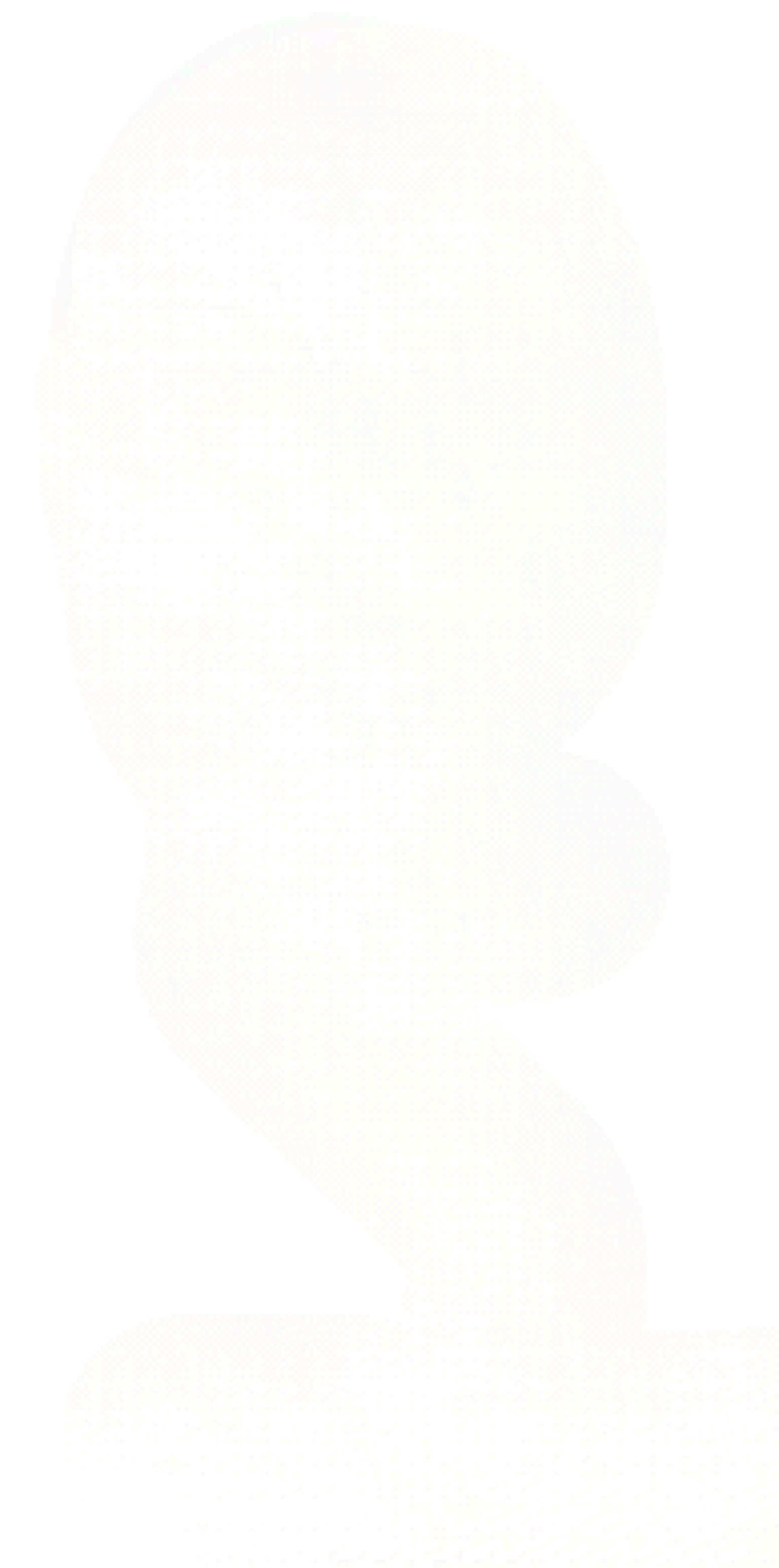
Ears

Cut 10 strands of MC and 4 strands Heather Grey 12" [30.5 cm] long.

Taking 5 strands of MC and 2 strands of Heather Grey tog, loop through sts at top of Hat on either side. Knot and trim to approx 1" [2.5 cm].

Use wire brush to fluff! Rep for opposite Ear.

Note: You can also use the wire brush to lightly comb over the Hat to create a layer of "fur"!

Crochet Needle:

5.5 mm [US I-9]

Yarn Needle

**DIMENSIONS: 13 sts = 10 cm;
10 rows = 10 cm, halfway down**

Crochet Needle

**CHECK YOUR SIZE. Use any size crochet hook to achieve
the given measurement.**





**Directions are for size 6 months.
Changes for sizes 12 months and Child
are in parentheses.**

**Hat measures 16 (18, 20)" [40.5 (45.75,
50.8) cm] circumference and 5¼ (6½,
7¼)" [14.5 (16.5, 18.5) cm] long.**

HAT Crown

Make an adjustable ring as follows:

Wrap yarn around your finger with the yarn tail to the left and under the working yarn. Insert hook through the circle from front to back. Using the working yarn, yarn over and pull up a loop.

Round 1: Ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), work 9 hdc into adjustable ring; slip st to top of beginning ch to join – 10 hdc. Pull beginning yarn tail to close adjustable ring.

Round 2: Ch 2, hdc in same st, work 2 hdc in each hdc around; slip st to top of beginning ch to join round – 20 hdc.

Round 3: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around; slip st to top of beginning ch to join.

Round 4: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next hdc, * 2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in next hdc; repeat from * around, slip st to top of beginning ch to join – 30 hdc.

Round 5: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around; slip st to top of beginning ch to join.

Round 6: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 2 hdc, * 2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in next 2 hdc; repeat from * around, slip st to top of beginning ch to join – 40 hdc.

Round 7: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around; slip st to top of beginning ch to join.

Round 8: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 3 hdc, * 2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in next 3 hdc; repeat from * around, slip st to top of beginning ch to join – 50 hdc.

Round 9: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around; slip st to top of beginning ch to join.

Round 10: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 24 (4, 4) hdc, * 2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in next 24 (4, 4) hdc; repeat from * around, slip st to top of beginning ch to join – 52 (60, 60) hdc.

Size Child ONLY:

Round 11: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around; slip st to top of beginning ch to join.

Round 12: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 11 hdc, * 2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in next 11 hdc; repeat from * around, slip st to top of beginning ch to join – 65 hdc.

Body (All Sizes):

Round 1: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around; slip st to top of beginning ch to join, turn.

Repeat Round 1 four (six, six) times.

Last round: Ch 1, sc in same st and each st around, slip st to 1st sc to join.

Fasten off, leaving a 6" (15.25 cm) tail.

Ear (make 2)

Make adjustable ring; yarn over and pull up a loop.

Row 1: Ch 2, work 7 hdc into ring, turn. Pull beginning yarn tail to close adjustable ring.

Row 2: Ch 2, 2 hdc in 1st hdc, hdc in next 5 hdc, 2 hdc in last hdc, turn – 9 hdc.

Row 3: Ch 2, 2 hdc in 1st hdc, hdc in next 7 hdc, 2 hdc in last hdc – 11 hdc. Fasten off, leaving a 6" (15.25 cm) tail.



FINISHING

With right side facing, flatten hat with the joining seam at the center back. Center one Ear on the 5th (6th, 6th) round of the flattened hat crown. Using the Ear yarn tail and yarn needle, sew the ear in place. Repeat on the opposite side with the second ear.

With yarn needle, weave in all loose ends.

Materials;
1 ball each
Cotton A and Rosewater B

Crochet Hooks:
5.0mm [US H-8]
Yarn needle

GAUGE: 16 sc and 16 rows of
sc = 4" [10 cm], 5 bobbles in
pattern = 4" [10 cm]. **CHECK**
YOUR GAUGE. Use any size
hook to obtain the gauge
given.

Hat directions are for size 16" (40.5 cm) head with changes for size 18" (45.5 cm) and 20" (51 cm) in parentheses.

Special Stitches

Bobble = [Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops] 5 times, yarn over and draw through 5 loops, yarn over and draw through remaining 2 loops.

sc2tog = [draw up a loop in next st] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

HAT Band

With **A**, ch 7.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook (beginning ch-1 does not count as a st, now and throughout) and each ch across; turn—6 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc across; turn. Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 16" [40.5 cm] long. (18" [45.5 cm], 20 [51 cm]).

Body

Row 1 (Right Side): Ch 1, work 54 (63, 72) sc evenly spaced along long edge of Band; turn—54, 63, 72 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, *sc in next 2 sc, bobble in next sc; repeat from * across; turn—18 (21, 24) bobbles, 36 (42, 48) sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, *sc in top of bobble, sc in next 2 sc; repeat from * across; turn—54 (63, 72) sc.

Row 4: Ch 1, *bobble in next sc, sc in next 2 sc; repeat from * across; turn—18 (21, 24) bobbles, 36 (42, 48) sc.

Row 5: Ch 1, *sc in next 2 sc, sc in top of bobble; repeat from * across; turn—54 (63, 72) sc.

Rows 6-14 (6-18, 6-18): Repeat Rows 2-5 another 2 (3, 3) times, then work Row 2 once.



Shape Crown

Row 1 (Right Side): Ch 1, *sc in next 4 (5, 6) sts, sc2tog; repeat from * across; turn—45 (54, 63) sts.

Row 2: Ch 1, *bobble in next sc, sc in next 2 sc; repeat from * across; turn—15 (18, 21) bobbles, 30 (36, 42) sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, *sc in next 3 (4, 5) sts, sc2tog; repeat from * across; turn—36 (45, 54) sts.

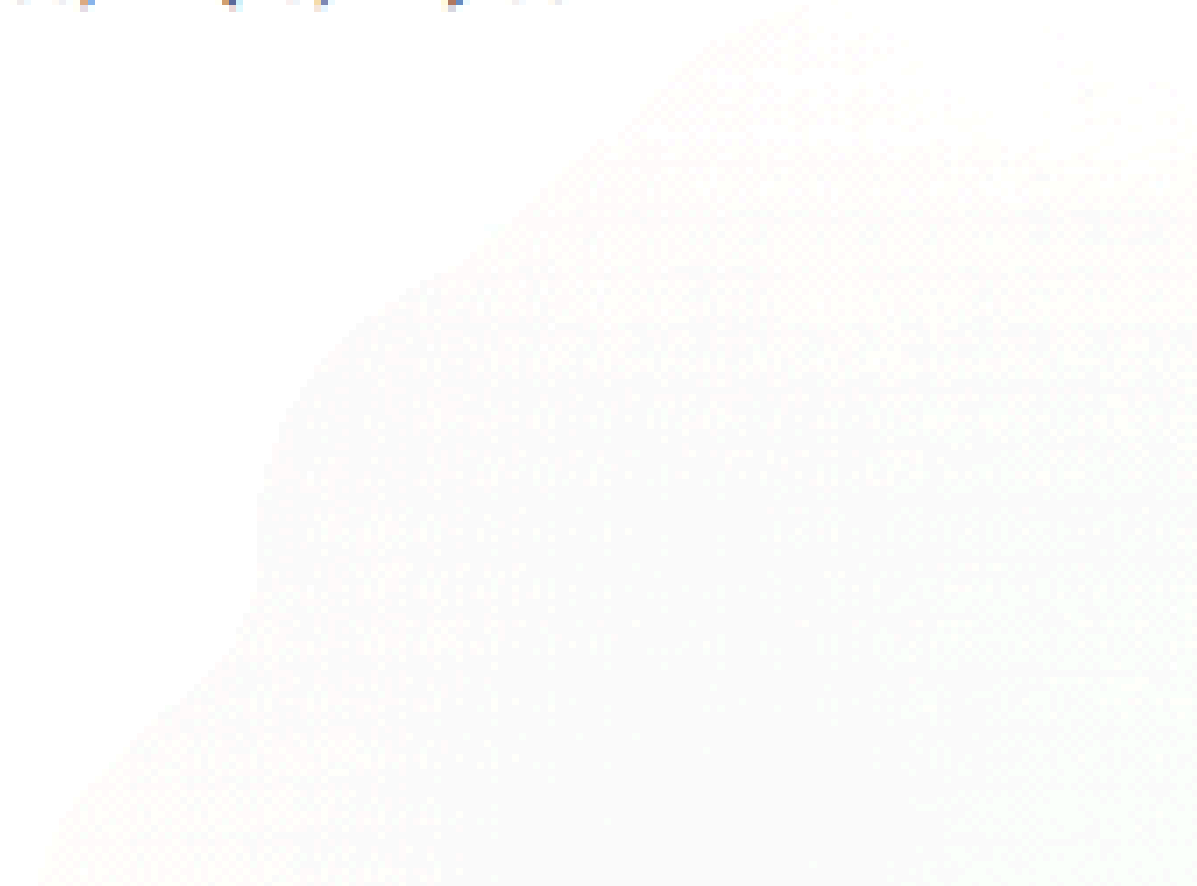
Row 4: Ch 1, *sc in next 2 sc, bobble in next sc; repeat from * across; turn—12 (15, 18) bobbles, 24 (30, 36) sc.

Row 5: Ch 1, *sc in next 2 (3, 4) sts, sc2tog; repeat from * across; turn—27 (36, 45) sts.

Row 6: Ch 1, *bobble in next sc, sc in next 2 sc; repeat from * across; turn—9 (12, 15) bobbles, 18 (24, 30) sc.

Row 7: Ch 1, *sc in next 1 (2, 3) st(s), sc2tog; repeat from * across; turn—18 (27, 36) sts.

Row 8: Ch 1, *sc in next 2 sc, bobble in next sc; repeat from * across; turn—6 (9, 12) bobbles, 12 (18, 24) sc.



For Size 16" (40.5 cm)

Row 9: Ch 1, sc2tog 9 times; turn—9 sts.

Row 10: Ch 1, *bobble in next sc, sc in next 2 sc; repeat from * across—3 bobbles, 6 sc. Fasten off, leaving an 18" (45.5 cm) tail.

For Size 18" (45.5 cm)

Row 9: Ch 1, *sc in next st, sc2tog; repeat from * across; turn—18 sts.

Row 10: Ch 1, *bobble in next sc, sc in next 2 sc; repeat from * across; turn—6 bobbles, 12 sc.

Row 11: Ch 1, sc2tog 9 times; turn—9 sts.

Row 12: Ch 1, *sc in next 2 sc, bobble in next sc; repeat from * across—3 bobbles, 6 sc. Fasten off, leaving an 18" (45.5 cm) tail.

For Size 20" (51 cm)

Row 9: Ch 1, *sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog; repeat from * across; turn—27 sts.

Row 10: Ch 1, *bobble in next sc, sc in next 2 sc; repeat from * across; turn—9 bobbles, 18 sc.

Row 11: Ch 1, *sc in next st, sc2tog; repeat from * across; turn—18 sts.

Row 12: Ch 1, *sc in next 2 sc, bobble in next sc; repeat from * across; turn—6 bobbles, 12 sc.

Row 13: Ch 1, sc2tog 9 times; turn—9 sts.

Row 14: Ch 1, *bobble in next sc, sc in next 2 sc; repeat from * across—3 bobbles, 6 sc. Fasten off, leaving an 18" (45.5 cm) tail.

All Sizes

Use tail to sew seam down back of Hat, weave in ends.

EARS (Make 2)

Inner Ear

With **B**, ch 11.

Row 1 (Right Side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and next 8 chs, 3 sc in last ch; working up other side of foundation ch, sc in next 9 chs; turn—21 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first 10 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 10 sc—23 sc. Fasten off and set aside.

Outer Ear

With **A**, ch 11.

Row 1 (Right Side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and next 8 chs, 3 sc in last ch; working up other side of foundation ch, sc in next 9 chs; turn—21 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first 10 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 10 sc; turn—23 sc. Place Inner Ear on top of Outer Ear.

Row 3: Continuing with **A** and working through both Inner Ear and Outer Ear held together; ch 1, sc in next 11 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 11 sc; turn—25 sc.

Rows 4 and 5: Ch 1, sc in each sc around. At end of Row 5, do not turn; fasten off and weave in ends.

FINISHING

Referring to photo for placement, position Ears at sides of Hat and sew in place.

A, B = Color A, Color B; **ch** = chain; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch (es); **()** = work directions in parentheses into same st; ***** = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
