

## VIKING WARRIOR HELMET HAT



**SIZES: NB (0-3 mo) / 3 mo / 6 mo / 12 mo / Toddler / Child**

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## Materials

Hook – Sizes G / H / I

Yarn – Caron One Pound (soft grey) 4 ply worsted weight for MC (main color) approx. 3 oz; and small amount of white for horns and any color for braids

Misc Supplies – fiberfill stuffing

## Stitches / Abbreviations

CH – chain

ST – stitch

SL ST – slip stitch

SC – single crochet

HDC – half double crochet

DC – double crochet

FPDC – front post double crochet

FPTC – front post triple crochet

BLO – back loop only

RS – right side

WS – wrong side

PS – puff stitch (\*YO, insert hook into stitch and pull up loop; YO and pull thru 2 loops on hook\*; repeat \* to \* 4 more times until you have 6 loops on hook. YO and pull through all loops)

## Gauge

DC stitches with H hook – approx. 7 sts and 4 rows = 2"

\*\*NOTE: all sizes are based on standard sizing charts

## HELMET – NB 0-3 month (approx. 5 1/2" x 14")

With H hook and MC, CH 3, join to 1<sup>st</sup> stitch to form ring

Rnd 1: CH 2, 12 DC in ring, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (12 sts)

Rnd 2: CH 2, \*2DC in 1<sup>st</sup> ST, DC and FPDC in next ST, FPDC in next ST; increase made\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (20 sts)

Rnd 3: CH 2, \*2 DC in 1<sup>st</sup> ST, DC in next 2 STS, DC and FPDC in next FPDC, FPDC in next FPDC; increase made\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (28 sts)

Rnd 4: CH 2, \*2 DC in first ST, DC in next 3 STS, 2 DC in next ST, DC and FPDC in next FPDC, FPDC in next FPDC; increase made\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (40 sts)

Rnd 5: CH 2, \*DC in next 8 STS, DC and FPDC in next FPDC, FPDC in next FPDC\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (44 sts)

Rnd 6-7: CH 2, \*DC in next 9 STS, FPDC in next 2 FPDC\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (44 sts)

Rnd 8: CH 2, \*DC in next 9 STS, FPTC in next 2 FPTC\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (44)

Rnd 9: CH 1, Working in BLO, SC in each ST; join to 1<sup>st</sup> SC and TURN (44 sts)

Rnd 10: CH 2, \*DC in next 5 STS, work 1 PS (puff stitch) in next ST\*; repeat \* to \*; join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC and TURN (44 sts)

Rnd 11: CH 1, Working in BLO, SC in each ST; join to 1<sup>st</sup> SC; fasten and weave ends (44 sts)

### **HELMET – 3 month (approx. 6" x 15")**

With I hook and MC, CH 3, join to 1<sup>st</sup> stitch to form ring

Rnd 1: CH 2, 12 DC in ring, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (12 sts)

Rnd 2: CH 2, \*2DC in 1<sup>st</sup> ST, DC and FPDC in next ST, FPDC in next ST; increase made\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (20 sts)

Rnd 3: CH 2, \*2 DC in 1<sup>st</sup> ST, DC in next 2 STS, DC and FPDC in next FPDC, FPDC in next FPDC; increase made\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (28 sts)

Rnd 4: CH 2, \*2 DC in first ST, DC in next 3 STS, 2 DC in next ST, DC and FPDC in next FPDC, FPDC in next FPDC; increase made\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (40 sts)

Rnd 5: CH 2, \*DC in next 8 STS, DC and FPDC in next FPDC, FPDC in next FPDC\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (44 sts)

Rnd 6-7: CH 2, \*DC in next 9 STS, FPDC in next 2 FPDC\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (44 sts)

Rnd 8: CH 2, \*DC in next 9 STS, FPTC in next 2 FPTC\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (44)

Rnd 9: CH 1, Working in BLO, SC in each ST; join to 1<sup>st</sup> SC and TURN (44 sts)

Rnd 10: CH 2, \*DC in next 5 STS, work 1 PS (puff stitch) in next ST\*; repeat \* to \*; join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC and TURN (44 sts)

Rnd 11: CH 1, Working in BLO, SC in each ST; join to 1<sup>st</sup> SC; fasten and weave ends (44 sts)

### **HELMET – 6 month (approx. 6 1/2" x 16")**

With H hook and MC, CH 3, join to 1<sup>st</sup> stitch to form ring

Rnd 1: CH 2, 12 DC in ring, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (12 sts)

Rnd 2: CH 2, \*2DC in 1<sup>st</sup> ST, DC and FPDC in next ST, FPDC in next ST; increase made\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (20 sts)

Rnd 3: CH 2, \*2 DC in 1<sup>st</sup> ST, DC in next 2 STS, DC and FPDC in next FPDC, FPDC in next FPDC; increase made\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (28 sts)

Rnd 4: CH 2, \*2 DC in first ST, DC in next 3 STS, 2 DC in next ST, DC and FPDC in next FPDC, FPDC in next FPDC; increase made\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (40 sts)

Rnd 5: CH 2, \*2 DC in first ST, DC in next 7 STS, DC and FPDC in next FPDC, FPDC in next FPDC\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (48 sts)

Rnd 6 – 9: CH 2, \*DC in next 10 STS, FPDC in next 2 FPDC\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (48)

Rnd 10: CH 2, \*DC in next 10 STS, FPTC in next 2 FPTC\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (48)

Rnd 11: CH 1, Working in BLO, SC in each ST; join to 1<sup>st</sup> SC and TURN (48 sts)

Rnd 12: CH 2, \*DC in next 5 STS, work 1 PS (puff stitch) in next ST\*; repeat \* to \*; join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC and TURN (48 sts)

Rnd 13: CH 1, Working in BLO, SC in each ST; join to 1<sup>st</sup> SC; fasten and weave ends (48 sts)

### **HELMET – 12 month (approx. 7" x 17")**

With H hook and MC, CH 3, join to 1<sup>st</sup> stitch to form ring

Rnd 1: CH 2, 12 DC in ring, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (12 sts)

Rnd 2: CH 2, \*2DC in 1<sup>st</sup> ST, DC and FPDC in next ST, FPDC in next ST; increase made\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (20 sts)

Rnd 3: CH 2, \*2 DC in 1<sup>st</sup> ST, DC in next 2 STS, DC and FPDC in next FPDC, FPDC in next FPDC; increase made\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (28 sts)

Rnd 4: CH 2, \*2 DC in first ST, DC in next 3 STS, 2 DC in next ST, DC and FPDC in next FPDC, FPDC in next FPDC; increase made\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (40 sts)

Rnd 5: CH 2, \*2 DC in first ST, DC in next 7 STS, DC and FPDC in next FPDC, FPDC in next FPDC\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (48 sts)

Rnd 6: CH 2, \*DC in next 10 STS, DC and FPDC in next FPDC, FPDC in next FPDC\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (52 sts)

Rnd 7-10: CH 2, \*DC in next 11 STS, FPDC in next 2 FPDC\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (52)

Rnd 11: CH 2, \*DC in next 11 STS, FPTC in next 2 FPTC\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (52)

Rnd 12: CH 1, Working in BLO, SC in each ST; join to 1<sup>st</sup> SC and TURN (52 sts)

Rnd 13: CH 2, \*DC in next 5 STS, work 1 PS (puff stitch) in next ST\*; repeat \* to \*; join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC and TURN (52 sts)

Rnd 14: CH 1, Working in BLO, SC in each ST; join to 1<sup>st</sup> SC; fasten and weave ends (52 sts)

### **HELMET – Toddler 2-5 years (approx. 7 1/2" x 18")**

With I hook and MC, CH 3, join to 1<sup>st</sup> stitch to form ring

Rnd 1: CH 2, 12 DC in ring, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (12 sts)

Rnd 2: CH 2, \*2DC in 1<sup>st</sup> ST, DC and FPDC in next ST, FPDC in next ST; increase made\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (20 sts)

Rnd 3: CH 2, \*2 DC in 1<sup>st</sup> ST, DC in next 2 STS, DC and FPDC in next FPDC, FPDC in next FPDC; increase made\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (28 sts)

Rnd 4: CH 2, \*2 DC in first ST, DC in next 3 STS, 2 DC in next ST, DC and FPDC in next FPDC, FPDC in next FPDC; increase made\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (40 sts)

Rnd 5: CH 2, \*2 DC in first ST, DC in next 7 STS, DC and FPDC in next FPDC, FPDC in next FPDC\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (48 sts)

Rnd 6: CH 2, \*DC in next 10 STS, DC and FPDC in next FPDC, FPDC in next FPDC\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (52 sts)

Rnd 7-10: CH 2, \*DC in next 11 STS, FPDC in next 2 FPDC\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (52)

Rnd 11: CH 2, \*DC in next 11 STS, FPTC in next 2 FPTC\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (52)

Rnd 12: CH 1, Working in BLO, SC in each ST; join to 1<sup>st</sup> SC and TURN (52 sts)

Rnd 13: CH 2, \*DC in next 5 STS, work 1 PS (puff stitch) in next ST\*; repeat \* to \*; join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC and TURN (52 sts)

Rnd 14: CH 1, Working in BLO, SC in each ST; join to 1<sup>st</sup> SC; fasten and weave ends (52 sts)

### **HELMET – Child 6-10 years (approx. 8" x 19")**

With I hook and MC, CH 3, join to 1<sup>st</sup> stitch to form ring

Rnd 1: CH 2, 12 DC in ring, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (12 sts)

Rnd 2: CH 2, \*2DC in 1<sup>st</sup> ST, DC and FPDC in next ST, FPDC in next ST; increase made\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (20 sts)

Rnd 3: CH 2, \*2 DC in 1<sup>st</sup> ST, DC in next 2 STS, DC and FPDC in next FPDC, FPDC in next FPDC; increase made\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (28 sts)

Rnd 4: CH 2, \*2 DC in first ST, DC in next 3 STS, 2 DC in next ST, DC and FPDC in next FPDC, FPDC in next FPDC; increase made\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (40 sts)

Rnd 5: CH 2, \*2 DC in first ST, DC in next 8 STS, DC and FPDC in next FPDC, FPDC in next FPDC\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (48 sts)

Rnd 6: CH 2, \*2 DC in first ST, DC in next 9 STS, DC and FPDC in next FPDC, FPDC in next FPDC\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (56 sts)

Rnd 7-11: CH 2, \*DC in next 12 STS, FPDC in next 2 FPDC\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (56)

Rnd 12: CH 2, \*DC in next 12 STS, FPTC in next 2 FPTC\*, repeat from \* to \*, join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC (56)

Rnd 13: CH 1, Working in BLO, SC in each ST; join to 1<sup>st</sup> SC and TURN (56 sts)

Rnd 14: CH 2, \*DC in next 5 STS, work 1 PS (puff stitch) in next ST\*; repeat \* to \*; join to 1<sup>st</sup> DC and TURN (56 sts)

Rnd 15: CH 1, Working in BLO, SC in each ST; join to 1<sup>st</sup> SC; fasten and weave ends (56 sts)

### **HORNS – ALL SIZES (MAKE 2)**

\*\* The horns are worked in continuous rounds; **DO NOT JOIN AT END OF ROUND**. I highly recommend using a stitch marker to keep track of the start of each round. \*\*

With **WHITE** and G hook, CH 2

RND 1: 5 SC in 1<sup>st</sup> CH ST

RND 2: 2 SC in same ST, 4 SC

RND 3: 1 SC, 2 SC in next ST, 4 SC

RND 4: 1 SC, 2 SC in next ST (2 times), 2 SC, SC 2 ST together

RND 5: 2 SC, 2 SC in next ST, 5 SC

RND 6: 3 SC, 2 SC in next ST (2 times), 3 SC, SC 2 ST together

\*\* (from RND 6 to the finish you will SC together last st of one round and 1<sup>st</sup> stitch of the next round; just continue your count as stated starting next round in next ST)

RND 7: 3 SC, 2 SC in next ST, 6 SC

RND 8: 4 SC, 2 SC in next ST (2 times), 4 SC, SC 2 ST together

RND 9: 4 SC, 2 SC in next ST, 7 SC

RND 10: 5 SC, 2 SC in next ST (2 times), 5 SC, SC 2 ST together

RND 11: 5 SC, 2 SC in next ST, 8 SC

**\*\*NOTE:** If you prefer bit smaller size horns for NB - 3 mo - 6 mo size, attach **GREY** at end of Rnd 11; skip Rnd 12 and continue with Rnd 13

RND 12: 6 SC, 2 SC in next ST (2 times), 6 SC, SC 2 ST together; fasten **WHITE** and attach **GREY**

RND 13: With **GREY**, 6 SC, 2 SC in next ST, 9 SC

RND 14: SC in each ST around

RND 15: SC in each ST around, SL ST to 1<sup>st</sup> SC and fasten off leaving long tail to sew.

Roll up grey rows to form a “cuff”; fill horns with stuffing

With long tail, sew horns onto hat centering approximately 3” down from top of hat and over the side FPDC ridges (see photo below for example)



### **BRAIDS (makes 2 braids)**

\*\*Photos attached to assist with placement.

Lay hat flat with front side facing up. Place a stitch marker in center stitch on each side.

NOTE: Strands of yarn are attached to the last (bottom) row of hat.

Cut 30 pieces of hair color approximately 22" long each; longer if you prefer.

Pull 3 strands of yarn through the stitch with the marker; and the next 2 stitches towards the back of the hat and next 2 stitches towards the front of the hat (5 stitches). Even out all bottom ends of the "hanging" strands

You now have a total of 30 strands on each side. Divide into 3 sections of 10 strands and proceed to making a braid. Cut a small 6" strand of yarn (any color); secure and tie a knot at the bottom of braid to secure. Trim all ends evenly.
